## Day 1

When you disembark, start out by visiting the Catalina Island Interpretive Center to learn about the island's natural and political history in the context of the greater Los Angeles area. Next, take a tour of the island and visit the architectural and natural splendors of the island on a guided tour. No trip to Catalina is complete without a visit to the Casino. It overlooks the bay and gives the visitor the ability to visit the past while enjoying the view. Both The Landing and The Blue Parrot offer great meals to enjoying the remainder of your day meandering The Wrigley Memorial and Botanical Gardens.
